What: A three-day USA Cycling stage race: Stage 1 - time trial prologue, Stage 2 - road race, Stage 3 - circuit race. Riders MUST complete each stage in order to start the next stage (except Novice riders-see Tech Guide).

When and Where: TT Prologue- Friday, March 3rd, Road Race Saturday a.m., March 4th, Circuit Race Sunday a.m., March 5th. For course layouts, times and venue locations see official 2023 Tech Guide posted at <https://www.tucsonbicycleclassic.com/>

Entry Fees: **Men Pro/1 & Women Pro/1/2: \$170 Juniors (13-18): \$60 Juniors (9-12): \$40 ALL OTHER ADULT CATEGORIES: \$140** Fees include mandatory USA Cycling daily surcharge but not BikeReg service fee or AZ sales tax

Discounts: 20% "Early Bird" discount, if you register online prior to midnight MT on December 25, 2022

TT Equipment. Equipment is limited to road bikes, aero wheels and helmets that are permissible in a mass start road race under USA Cycling rules. Other aero equipment prohibited. See Tech Guide for further information. Ask if in doubt.

GPS Locations: See Tech Guide for GPS venue locations and further directions and rider parking.

Bib Pickup. Bib pickup held at host hotel from 4:00 to 8:00 pm on Thursday, March 2nd. (See Tech Guide) Riders strongly encouraged to pick up bibs then. Be prepared to present your USA Cycling license or valid international license then. **NO RESTARTS or late start requests.**
