2.0 mi. Turn left onto Woodville Rd 1.4 mi. Turn right onto Switch Rd. Destination will
be on the right 0.7 mi

Fine print: All USA Cycling rules apply. Approved helmets required. USA Cycling
license required for all events.

**One-day licenses may be purchased via this event's BikeReg site for \$10 and are
valid for a single day of racing. On-site One-day licenses may only be purchased
by Category 5 Men and Women, for use in races open to those categories.**

Only riders with annual USAC licenses from New England are eligible for Regional
Championship medals. All others will compete for Bob Beal Memorial Race medals.

**Warm up: No warming up on the course. Public roads around the
school complex and near the start of the TT course are NOT closed
to traffic. It is suggested you warm up on stationary trainer. Use of
public roads is at your own risk.**

Start:

Age 15+ juniors and all adults: first rider starts at 9:30 AM, others follow at 30 second
intervals.

Junior 9-12 & 13-14: start at 10:45 AM, others follow at 30 second intervals.

Course for all competitors except Juniors 9-12, & 13-14: 21K gently rolling,
challenging circuit

Course for Juniors 9-12 & 13-14: This year, juniors will start at the same place as the adult
riders (Rt 91 just east of Switch Road) and will do a u-turn at the end of Rt 91 (police will block
traffic for the u-turn) return along Rt 91 westbound, and finish right across the road from the
start. Each junior rider will also be escorted by an adult rider. This new course is flat, and about
6.6 K long.

* Eddy Merckx Class: Road Bikes only, no aero bars of any type, no aero helmets, no booties and no disc wheels, deep profile wheels up to 40mm may be used.

Awards: NEBRA New England champions medals for top three New England riders in each category. Juniors will compete for USA Cycling Road Development Race Series (RDRS) Medals. Riders and teams from outside of the region and Eddy Merckx Class riders who place in the top three will be awarded Bob Beal Memorial Race medals.
