## E-BIKE POLICY

Class 1 (pedal assist under 20 mph) e-bikes are permitted on Western Slope trails. E-bikes of any classification are not permitted on National Forest trails, which includes Kaylor's Knob trail past intersection H and Laird's Downhill past intersection G.
