## **Bristol Mountain Road Race**

2018 marks the <u>25<sup>th</sup> edition</u> of Western NY's preeminent Spring Monument. Each field will have a neutral roll out from <u>Levi Corser Memorial Park</u> which is located at <u>6740 County Rd 32; Canandaigua, NY 14424</u>. Recommended gearing is 11-28. The <u>course</u> is 47 miles with 3,800 feet of climbing. The race is held under <u>USA Cycling</u> Permit # 2018-1100 rain, snow, or shine. Register online at <u>http://www.BikeReg.com/BMRR</u>.

- Check-in opens day of event at 8:30AM and closes 30 minutes prior to race start.
- Current annual USA Cycling license or annual international cycling license must be presented at sign in. Proof may be in the form of a physical license or using the <u>"My USAC" mobile application</u>.
- One day licenses available for junior, cat 5 men, cat 5 women, and citizen racers for an additional \$10.
- All masters' racers must hold an annual license to participate in master's race field and be category 1-4.
- Any masters' fields with less than five entries at the start of the event will be scored in the next appropriate field (The next lowest age group with five or more racers, the category 3/4 race, or the open).
- Different fields <u>may not</u> ride together during the race <u>unless</u> they start at the same time.
- There will be multiple fields on the race course at one time. Please stay to your right and hold your line when being passed. Neutralize, if necessary, to avoid interfering.
- Promoter reserves right to combine or cancel fields.
- At all times, racers will remain to the right of the center of the road and will not be permitted to cross over the center line; this rule is strictly enforced by the race officials. Law enforcement may issue tickets.
- A 'Broom Wagon' will follow along course loop to collect riders who have abandoned.
- Free entry for all junior racers courtesy of the <u>Western New York Bike Racing Club</u>.
- Each group will roll out of parking lot going East onto Route 32 (Bristol Road). The riders will then take a right onto Route 64 under neutralized conditions for approximately 1 mile before racing begins. During the Neutral Start, no racing will be permitted.
- See <u>2018 Course Cue Sheet</u> and <u>Strava Route</u> for detailed course information. Course is subject to change.
- Maximum field limit is 100 racers unless it contains cat 5 women or cat 5 men which then it is 75 racers.
