Medical Control /Anti-Doping

The Rock Hill Criterium is subject to USADA Anti Doping Examination. All competitors and team personnel must abide by these regulations. Any rider found positive will forfeit all prizes won at the event.

The list of riders required to report will be posted at the start/finish stage. The riders will be required to report to medical control within a reasonable time after the awards and protocol ceremonies. It is the responsibility of the rider and/or their team personnel to ensure that they report to Anti-Doping within the required time.

Anti-doping testing will be located in the Novant Health BMX Supercross Building located adjacent to the criterium course.
USADA chaperones will escort you to the testing room.

The awards for Professional Events both men and women are held directly after the finish of the men's race. Top 3 riders from each event must report to the finish area immediately after the Men's Pro Race. Please participate in the awards ceremony before reporting for testing.
Your USADA chaperone will stay with you.

Professional Riders Call Ups

Riders for call up will be selected by the Race Director from pre-registration list on the evening of April 20, 2017
Call Up lists will be available at number pickup

We will allow as many call up as our time schedule allows.
Staging for call ups will be behind the fencing directly across from the start/finish stage.
There will be event staff there to assist.
We are on a strict timetable so please don't miss your call up!

All remaining riders will be staged 150 meters prior to the start line.

Awards Ceremony

Pro Women's Race Post Race Interview: The winner of the women's race should report to the Start/Finish stage immediately following the finish of her race. Our race announcer will conduct an interview before the start of the men's race and during the first few minutes of the men's race.

Following the Finish of the Pro Men's Race: The top 3 finishers from both the Men's and Women's race should report to the Start/Finish stage immediately following the finish of the Men's race at approximately 7:30 pm. These riders must report to the Awards Ceremony wearing team uniforms of both shorts and jersey.

Pro Women and Men's Awards Ceremony: There will be a combined awards ceremony with presentation of flowers to the winners in both the women's and men's race as well as a winner's check presentation to the winners. The awards ceremony for both men and women will be held directly after the finish of the men's race.

It is imperative that riders and managers respect our instructions above. Your assistance is highly important to us in order to meet our schedules and to give your team maximum exposure. Participation in the Awards Ceremony is required and must be completed before reporting for testing. *Failure to comply can incur a penalty of up to 50% of prize earnings.*

Pro Men's and Women's Placing Prizes and Premes:

All prize money, as well as all cash premes, for the Rock Hill Criterium will be paid out 30 minutes after the finish of your race and until 8:30 PM. Race number, ID and signature are required for prize pickup and the Registration Tent.

Amateur Race Prizes:

All places will be paid out at the Registration Tent 40 minutes after each amateur race finish. Please bring photo ID, Racing License or Race Number to pick up prizes. Thank you.

All photographers and press must be properly identified and credentialed by the Race Director or Public Relations Coordinator. Any photographers or press working in the start/finish area must obey the instructions of the Race Director or Public Relations Coordinator.

No photographer or press is allowed inside the fencing (on course) while races are in progress. No exceptions. These rules are in place to help in the safety of you and the competitors.

Men and Women's Pro Races Awards Ceremony: A fenced in area in front of the race awards stand will be available for all photographers and press for the post race awards ceremony at 7:45 pm
